



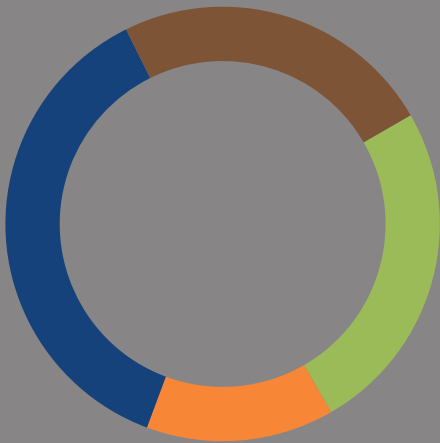
Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report
September 29th to October 5th, 2013

A total of **2,911 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

1,922 trucks carrying **54,833 tons** of goods entered Gaza
