November 10th to November 16th, 2013

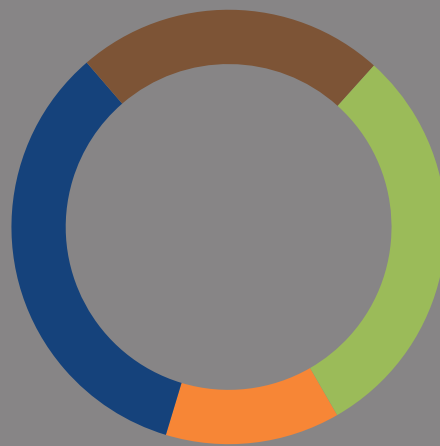
A total of **2,944 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal
