A total of **3,172 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

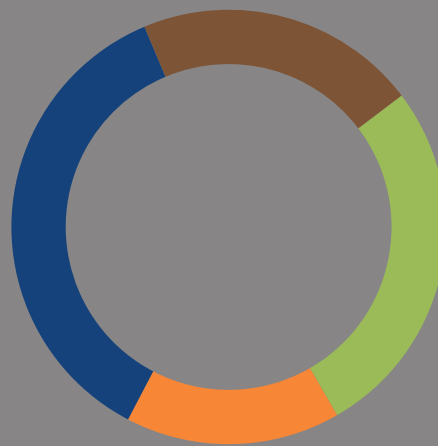
1,021 trucks carrying **21,661 tons** of goods entered Gaza

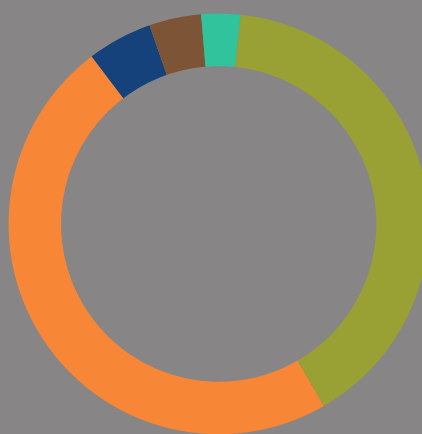
