A total of **3,028 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

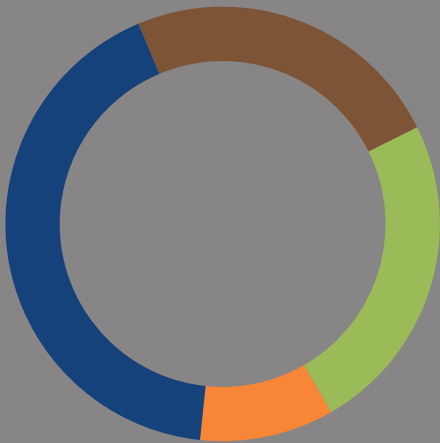
1,022 trucks carrying **23,610 tons** of goods entered Gaza
