A total of **2,679 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

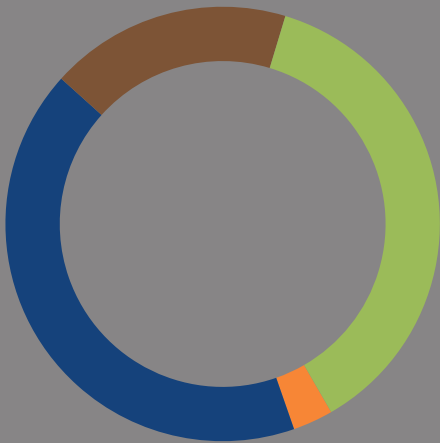
1,328 trucks carrying **30,720 tons** of goods entered Gaza
