



Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report


January 5th to January 11th 2013

A total of **3,385** people crossed through the Erez Terminal

1,115 trucks carrying **24,746** tons of goods entered Gaza

9 truckloads of cherry tomatoes, strawberries, flowers and spices were exported from the Gaza Strip


Erez Terminal - Pedestrian Crossing
