January 26th to February 1st 2014

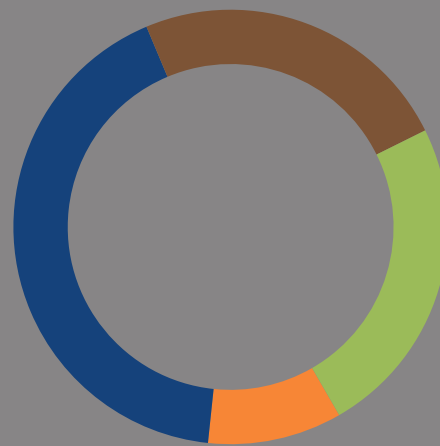
A total of **2,092 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

1,182 trucks carrying **29,659 tons** of goods entered Gaza
