February 2nd to February 8th 2014

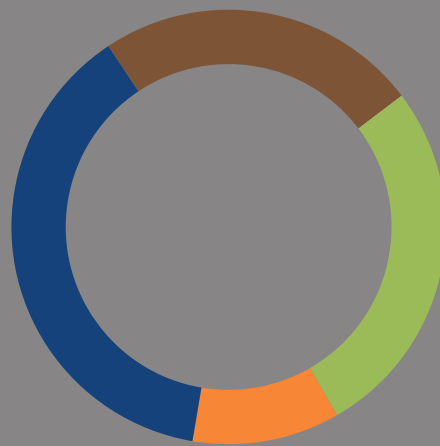
A total of **3,130 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

1,251 trucks carrying **31,451 tons** of goods entered Gaza
