A total of **3,550 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

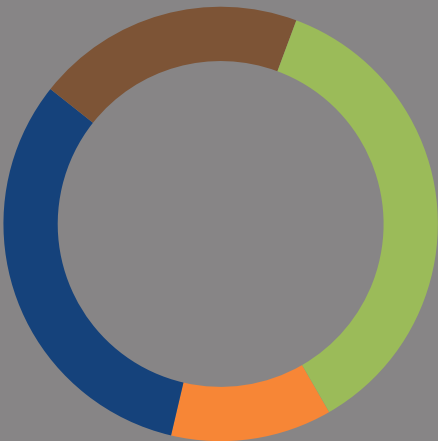
1,188 trucks carrying **30,398 tons** of goods entered Gaza
