5 truckloads of flowers, cherry tomatoes, spices and cucumbers were exported from the Gaza Strip



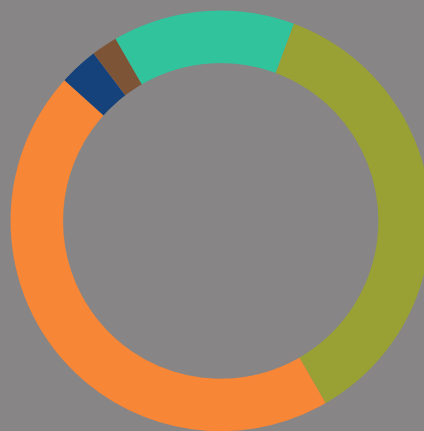
Erez Terminal - Pedestrian Crossing
