March 2<sup>nd</sup> to March 8<sup>th</sup> 2014

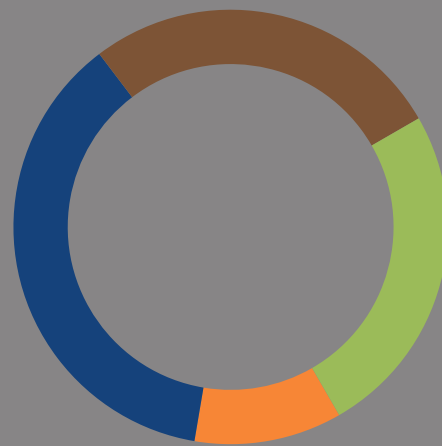
A total of **3,079 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

**1,100 trucks** carrying **26,762 tons** of goods entered Gaza

**6 truckloads** of flowers, tomatoes, spices and cherry tomatoes were exported from the Gaza Strip
