



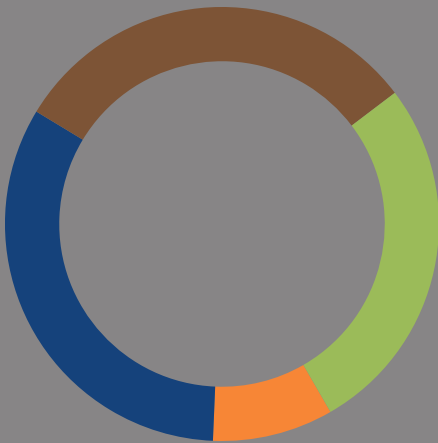
Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report
March 23rd to March 29th 2014

A total of **3,633 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

1,264 trucks carrying **29,260 tons** of goods entered Gaza

7 truckloads of peppers, tomatoes, spices and cucumbers were exported from the Gaza Strip
