



Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report


March 30th to April 5th 2014

A total of **3,138 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

1 truckloads of peppers, tomatoes, spices and cucumbers were exported from the Gaza Strip


Erez Terminal - Pedestrian Crossing
