



## Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report

April 27<sup>th</sup> to May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014

A total of **3,881 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

**1,540 trucks** carrying **38,837 tons** of goods entered Gaza

**0.8 truckloads** of hot peppers, cherry tomatoes, spices and cucumbers were exported from the Gaza Strip
