Daily Report: Civilian Assistance to Gaza Operation "Protective Edge"

On 28/7 a young Palestinian child suffering from cancer was treated at the COGAT field hospital. The doctors sent him for further care in Israel.

Since the **field hospital opened on 20/7**, doctors and staff have attended to **over 40 patients**. Some have been treated and released, some treated and sent on for additional care at a hospital, and some sent immediately for hospital care.

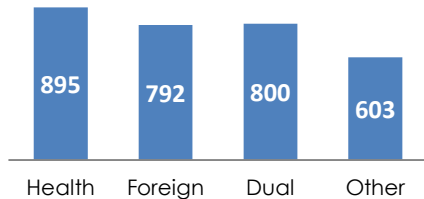
Unfortunately, **Hamas has directly and indirectly prevented patients from arriving** for care at the field hospital.

Erez Crossing

14 trucks of medicine and medical supplies for the **Jordanian Hospital** were transferred via Erez Crossing.

A total of **66 ambulance transfers** through Erez, **13 on July 28**.

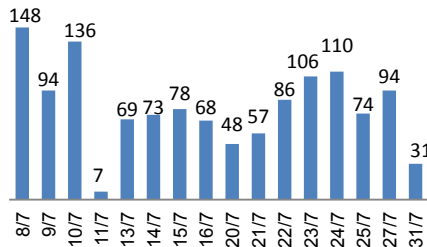
The **field hospital** features:

10 beds, emergency room, lab, pharmacy, pediatric ward, ambulatory clinic, gynecology unit, family and internal medicine.

Kerem Shalom

Total of **1,279** trucks entered via Kerem Shalom.



Due to the **Eid el Fiter holiday**, only goods and equipment from international donors were transferred through Kerem Shalom Crossing, including **60 tons of medicines and medical supplies**.

Total Energy Import to Gaza

4.44 million liters of **diesel** for the power station, **344K liters** for UNRWA.

2.816 million liters of **fuel** and **693K** liters of **benzene** for transportation.

1,557 tons of **gas** for domestic use.

Infrastructure

On 28 July, COGAT facilitated the **repair of two of the electrical feeder lines from Israel to northern Gaza**.

These lines provide electricity for roughly 110,000 people. Such repairs are a high priority effort, particularly since electrical malfunctions often impact other infrastructure.

Over the course of the operation all ten feeder lines from Israel have been damaged. Many have had multiple repairs, frequently due to **overload problems** that result from damage to the other lines. **Repairs are often delayed due to security threats**.

51 Infrastructural repairs total

- 27 electrical repairs.**
- 15 water supply repairs.**
- 4 sewage repairs.**
- 4 communication repairs.**
