Daily Report: Civilian Assistance to Gaza

Operation "Protective Edge"



On July 30th, **131 trucks** were scheduled to cross into Gaza; only **65 trucks** arrived at Kerem Shalom. Drivers on the Gaza and Israeli side are reluctant to come to the crossing due to Hamas mortar fire and the security situation.

Of the trucks that entered:

- **26 trucks** carrying **575 tons of food**.
- **11 trucks** carrying **440 tons of agricultural supplies**.
- **4 trucks** carrying **47 tons of medicine and medical supplies**.
- **24 trucks** carrying **169 tons of humanitarian supplies**.

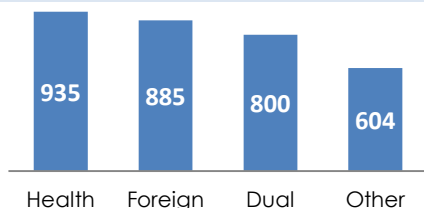

Erez Crossing

IDF forces evacuated a 75 year old woman from N. Gaza for treatment at the field hospital. She was later transferred for further care in Israel.

A total of **77 ambulance transfers** through Erez, **3 on July 30**.

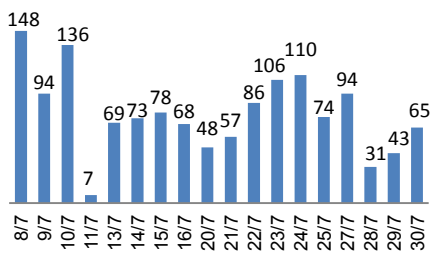
The **field hospital** features:

10 beds, emergency room, lab, pharmacy, pediatric ward, ambulatory clinic, gynecology unit, family and internal medicine.

Kerem Shalom

Total of **1,387** trucks entered via Kerem Shalom since July 8th.



Total Energy Import to Gaza

4.44 million liters of **diesel** for the power station, **344K liters** for UNRWA.

3.182 M liters of **fuel** and **1.02 M** liters of **benzene** for transportation.

1,557 tons of **gas** for domestic use.

Infrastructure

The **infrastructure situation in Gaza is very serious and continues to deteriorate**. Electricity is the primary concern; Gaza's sole power plant was damaged two days ago and cannot produce power. Two of the ten feeder lines from Israel were repaired on July 30th, each providing 12.5 MW.

COGAT is working with various stakeholders to try and find **immediate solutions** for the **electrical** and **water-related problems**.

Combat conditions present significant logistical challenges to coordinating repairs. Often they are **delayed due to security threats** and safety concerns for the workers.
